Their health issues deserve much attention like men since health care matter impact women differently than men. Cancer falls in as the second leading cause of death among women. Accordingly Resource persons were arranged from the Diocesan Nursing College.

GOD'S MARVELOUS WORKS

Since 27 years, The Helpers of Mary are rendering their service in the Mandvi mission for the upliftment of tribal community through education, empowering women, and income generation projects. Being a political and communal sensitive area the Sisters faced many challenges, difficulties and even risked their life during the course of many years. One of the continuous problems that the sisters faced was the issue of the land. Eventually, with a lot of phone calls, door knocking, paperwork, prayers and perseverance, the issue was resolved by registering the land in May 2016. After registering the land, the sisters were struggling to get the 7/12 since last two years. There are a number of documents required to buy property and to ensure if the asset is legally free of any claims or litigations. One such documents requirement in Maharashtra is the 7/12 extract.

June 06, 2018 was a remarkable day for us in Divya Jyoti, Mandvi. After a long wait the officers arrived to survey the land. Sr. Amrita Jose, newly elected Provincial of St. Anne's Province and Sr. Reshmi Almeida, the General Councilor were present during the survey. Mr. Shedmake, the Talati and his associates measured the land. After a long legal procedure, hard work and prayers we obtained the 7/12 extract and transferred the plot in the name of the Society. We thank God for the marvelous work he has done. Now we have our own land and we will continue to serve the people with much enthusiasm and commitment. Our faith in God is what sustained us and enabled us to go through challenging times and today we realize that God had a greater purpose in our struggles. We are truly grateful to Sr. Stella Devassy, our Superior General and all the Sisters for their prayerful support.

GIVING HOPE WHERE THERE'S DESPAIR



"Life laughs at you, when you are unhappy, Life smiles at you, when you are happy, Life salutes you when you make others happy." It was a great opportunity for me to visit Mangal Jadhav who is a bedridden patient for nearly three years. Mangal is 37 years old. Soon after her Masters in Commerce, she lost her mother and then suddenly within 15 days she lost her father. After her parents death she lost hope. Her brothers did not support her and started to torture her mentally. They wanted her to work, but she was unable to get a job according to her qualification. She went through a lot of tension and turmoil and this affected her health. She got paralyzed and lost her memory. Now for the last 3 years she is completely bedridden, but her faith in God

has kept her alive. She believes that "Jesus will never fail me" he will heal me completely. Two of her brothers are in good job, one in fact is a doctor, but they never pay her a visit. The brother with whom she is staying is very poor. She is just thrown outside the house where she is not comfortable and safe. We the sisters of Anand Vihar tried to take her to doctor for treatment but the Doctor has given up hope about her recovery as she is affected almost 75%. Sr. Shweta took her to civil hospital at Nagar to obtain

a Handicap certificate. Now she has the disable certificate and receives Rs. 3000 per month for her maintenance. Mangal is very grateful to the sisters of Anand Vihar. She always tells us that our constant visit gives her hope in life. Whenever we go to her we find tears of joy and gratefulness on her face.
